A service that Chance Shelter offers to the community is educating children and adults alike to bring a better understanding and respect for pets. Our educators, Kathy Bayer and Jenn Currie, have extensive knowledge experience in the EMT field. Both have CPR training and share this with the community in caring for their pets. We offer classes for children of all ages teaching pet safety and responsibility. For adults we offer courses

including topics such as AZ laws and ordinances, basic first aid and signs of illness, plus an opportunity to learn pet CPR. We offered two CPR courses during the first quarter of 2019. Each quarter we offer this course which is open to the public. There is a \$20 fee and registration is required. Any Chance Shelter volunteer or foster can attend free of charge.
