## Chief Executive Summary

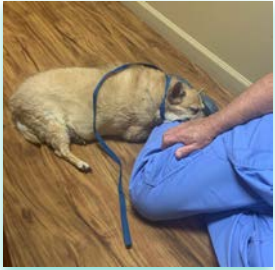

2021 proved to be a busy year for Chance Shelter. We started the year off feeling honored when we received a Congressional Recognition for our service to the community.



Our Neighbor to Neighbor Program became, and still remains, busy with intakes for pets in crisis. This year we served over 50 pets through this program. These pets were cared for by our loving fosters until they could be reunited with their owners. Some of the pets came to us more than once.

Through our Veterinarian Assist Program, we were able to provide 18 pets with basic veterinarian needs such as; spay, neuter, and vaccinations for owners who may have fallen on hard times.



Our Community Outreach Program kept us on our toes! We attended 11 outreach events, including our time at the Surprise Resource Center twice a month. These events helped us to provide over 32 pets with food and other supplies. We were able to courtesy post 9 pets to help owners with re-homing their pets.

We successfully placed 16 pets into new forever homes and we just received 7 more pets that will be available for adoption soon.



We had 7 fundraisers over this past year. We also attended several presentations in an effort to help us reach our goal of raising money for the building, and promoting public awareness for the need of an animal shelter in our community. Our conceptual drawings are in the hands of a Civil Engineer at this time.

Our added alliances have helped us in attaining our goals, and we are truly thankful for their support. Our dedicated volunteers assisted us in our efforts to serve pets in crisis situations, by averaging over 1,500 volunteer hours this past year.



Without supporters such as you, we could not continue to expand the much-needed programs we have set forth for the underserved segment of pets in our community. We truly thank you for your ongoing support of our vision and mission.

## 2021 Chance Shelter Accomplishments

- We have expanded our Community Outreach Program and we are now offering In-Kind donation drop-off opportunities at the Surprise Resource center twice a month.
- Chance Shelter was extremely busy providing foster care for pets whose owners were hospitalized with no one to care for their pets. Some of these pets returned to us several times while their owner's were in and out of hospital care. The pets were successfully returned to their owners once they were able to care for them.
- We increased our intake of animals which were in need of a new forever home and the pets were successfully adopted.
- While at the Surprise Resource Center we engage with community members who may need assistance for their pets, in providing them with pet supplies, and basic veterinarian care assistance. In addition, we have been able to offer these services to some neighboring communities.
- Our services were given a Congressional Recognition and our dedicated donors and sponsors increased their support so that we could continue assisting the needs of pets in the community.
- New and continual alliances with local businesses have assisted with discounted services, resources and training.
- Our conceptual drawings are completed and we are waiting on a drawings from a Civil Engineer.
- The Response Van that was purchased has truly been a strong force in providing safe transport of the pets. It has also provided a strong marketing addition and assists us with getting supplies to community events.
